

## Exemption from provisions of Health and Safety at Work (Hazardous Substances) Regulations 2017

In accordance with section 220 of the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 (the Act), I, Tony Hetherington, Head of High Hazards, Energy and Public Safety at WorkSafe New Zealand, exempt Chubb New Zealand Limited from compliance with regulations 15.13, 15.16 and 15.17 of the Health and Safety at Work (Hazardous Substances) Regulations 2017 for the requirements to have a design verification compliance certificate, cylinder pre-commissioning compliance certificate and a cylinder import compliance certificate in respect to the Worthington Cylinders GmbH cylinder with the serial number 3990FW.

I do so having had regard to the prescribed requirements in regulation 15.18 of the HS Regulations; and being satisfied that

- The cylinder is a close match to an approved design that conforms to an internationally recognised design standard for cylinder manufacture; and
- It is not reasonable for the cylinder to gain a pre-commissioning certificate under regulation 15.17 as that involves destructive testing.

An exemption is granted subject to the following conditions—

- 1. This exemption is limited to the Worthington Cylinders GmbH cylinder with serial number 3990FW.
- 2. Chubb New Zealand Limited must in accordance with regulation 15.60, stamp the cylinder with number 3990FW with:
  - a. the approval number LAB7726SP.
  - b. the station mark of the approved test station.
- 3. Chubb New Zealand Limited must not stamp the approval number LAB7726SP on any other cylinder.

This exemption takes effect on 25 June 2020 and expires on 25 June 2025 unless it is sooner replaced or revoked.
