

Amendment to Exemption from Provisions of the Health and Safety at Work (Hazardous Substances Regulations 2017)

In accordance with section 220 of the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 (the Act), I, Darren Handforth, Head of High Hazards, Energy and Public Safety, amend the exemption (SEP2007) from compliance with regulations 11.29, 11.30, 11.34, 11.36 and 11.37 of the Health and Safety at Work (Hazardous Substances Regulations (the HS Regulations)), which came into force on 25 January 2021 and was granted to PPG Industries New Zealand Limited.

I do so being satisfied that:

- The extent of the exemption, as amended, is not broader than is reasonably necessary to address the matters that gave rise to it; and
- The exemption, as amended, is not inconsistent with the purpose of the Act.

The terms and conditions of exemption SEP2007 are amended as follows:

1. Condition 4 is amended to read the following:

- (4) [PPG Industries New Zealand Limited must -] install a door between the office and warehouse to have a FRR of at least -/240/60 minutes within three months of this exemption coming into force^[1]; and

The amendment to the exemption takes effect on 31 March 2021 and expires on 25 January 2026.
